1. In CRM-M-29442-2022, the petitioner is seeking to quash the orders dated 10.03.2022 and 11.05.2022 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, vide which bail granted to the petitioner has been cancelled and non-bailable warrant has been issued in the case bearing FIR No. 0077, dated 18.06.2020, under Sections 354-B, 452, 323, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3(1)((u), 3(1)(W)(ii) of the Scheduled Castes and the

Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, registered at Police Station Sohna, District Gurugram.

2. In CRM-M-29580-2022, the petitioner is seeking to quash the order dated 22.03.2022 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, vide which bail granted to the petitioner has been cancelled and non-bailable warrant has been issued in the case bearing FIR No. 0041, dated 10.03.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 379-A of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, registered at Police Station Sohna, District Gurugram.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the arrest of the petitioner has been effected in another case and he has instructions to withdraw both the afore-mentioned petitions.

4. Both the afore-mentioned petitions i.e. CRM-M-29442-2022 and 29580-2022 are dismissed as withdrawn.
