The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for directing the official respondents to produce and release the detainee Gursimran Kaur, who is in the illegal detention of respondents No.4 to 6.

Detenue namely, Gursimran Kaur is present in person along with her both the children. This Court has interacted with the detenue and she has submitted that the divorce between her and respondent No.4 has already taken place. She has submitted that she was residing along with her children with petitioner and now has no difficulty in residing with him and she wants to accompany him. Respondent No.4 and respondent No.5 are also present in person and they have also submitted that the divorce has taken place and the allegations made against them are totally false and frivolous as they have never made any coercion whatsoever with

the alleged detainee for keeping her illegally in their custody.

After hearing counsel for the parties, parties present in person and perusing the record, it is apparent that both the sides are of the age of majority. Divorce has already taken place and now the detainee has submitted before the Court that she along with her twin daughters wants to go with the petitioner. Allowed to do so. Accordingly, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the parties to pursue their remedies for any grievances if at all in accordance with law.
