The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action on the complaint/representation dated 14.05.2023 submitted by the petitioner for registration of case against the accused persons, who forged documents and created false official record in order to take benefit in FIR No.92 dated 11.05.2022, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, u/s 406, 120-B IPC.

2. After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the main petition with a direction that in case, petitioner file a fresh representation, the concerned SP/Commissioner of Police, shall decide the same in a time bound manner.

3. Given the petitioner's stand, the present petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner, that in case he files a fresh representation within one month from today, the concerned SP/Commissioner of Police either personally or delegate the same to any IPS Officer under him, shall decide the same within two months from the date of its filing. It is clarified that such an order must be a reasoned order, and the same be communicated to the representationists without delay.

remedies in accordance with the law, in case the petitioners are not satisfied with the outcome.

5. It is clarified that there is no adjudication on merits and this order shall not come in the way if the interrogation of the petitioner is required in any cognizable case. It is further clarified that all the representations mentioned in the present petition, which are pending as on date, are treated to be closed.

6. *There would be no need for a certified copy of this order, and any Advocate for the Petitioner and State can download this order and other relevant particulars from the official web page of this court and attest it to be a true copy. The concerned officer can also verify its authenticity and may download and use the downloaded copy for immediate use.*

7. **Petition stands disposed of.** All pending applications, if any, stand disposed.
