JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

On 29.05.2023, the following order was passed:-

“The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of order dated 01.04.2023 passed by JMIC, Amritsar (Annexure P1) whereby the bail order dated 03.10.2019 was cancelled and his bail bonds and surety bonds were ordered to be forfeited to the State on account of non appearance on 01.04.2023 in FIR No.21 dated 25.07.2018 under Sections 447, 379, 427, 506, 510, 323, 148, 149 IPC P.S. Ranjit Avenue at Amritsar.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that a compromise has been effected between the parties and in terms of the same a quashing petition has been filed in which orders have been passed for recording of the statement of the parties. He is otherwise ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate within a period of one week from today and subject to his depositing Rs.50,000/- as costs with Spinal Rehab Centre, Chandigarh Plot NO.1, Madhya Marg, Sector 28-A, Chandigarh, he

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shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in terms of the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered on 03.06.2023 and has been released on interim bail. The copy of the said order is marked as X.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from Trial without sufficient cause.
