1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.41 dated 23.02.2023 registered under Sections 379-B and 34 of IPC at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad.

2. It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally false, concocted and fabricated. The petitioner is not involved in the crime at all, as alleged against him and even petitioner is not named in the FIR. Except showing the petitioner to be present at the spot there is no allegation against him. The petitioner is in custody since 23.02.2023.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Krishan K.Chahal, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, submits that the case against the petitioner is very serious. The amount of Rs.11,000/- was snatched by the co-accused of the petitioner. However, it is not disputed that except the allegation of being present at the spot there is no other serious allegation against the petitioner. It is also not disputed that the petitioner is in custody since 22.02.2023.

5. In view the above, but without expressing any further opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
