On 29.05.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

'The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 05.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Kapurthala in case titled as "State of Punjab Vs. Aman Basra @ Aman and others" in CIS No.SC/41/2020 in case FIR No.153 dated 17.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 160, 283, 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala whereby the bail and bail bonds of the petitioner have been ordered to cancel and non-bailable warrants have been issued against him.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was unable to appear on account of some urgent work because of which the impugned order came to be passed.

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He states that he is ready and willing to join proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.50,000/- as costs with the Chandi Kusht Ashram Society, Shiv Ram Mandir (Leprosy Colony), Sector 47, Opp. 3 BRD Gate, Chandigarh and on his doing he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court”.

The learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar, contend that in pursuance to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court on 01.06.2022 and has since been granted interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial but for a sufficient cause.
