1. The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C has been preferred for issuance of appropriate directions to the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar to decide CRM-1173-2023 titled “CSL Finance Limited Vs. Pawan Chopra” expeditiously in a time bound manner in accordance with law.

2. On a query put by the Court as to the maintainability of the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., learned counsel for the petitioner agrees that the same is not maintainable, as against the impugned order, there is a specific alternative remedy under Section 17 of SARFAESI Act.

3. It appears that petitioner has filed the present petition deliberately and intentionally, which has put in motion the whole judicial system and institution of this Court including the Registry Branch and other staff members and the same has resulted into consumption of pecuniary loss. Thus, in view of the above an exemplary cost of Rs.10,000/- is hereby imposed upon the petitioner, to be deposited in the **Widows' Welfare Fund**

created by Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
6. However, it is made clear that the cost imposed as above shall be deposited by the petitioner.
