Petitioner has prayed for grant of interim bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No. 09 dated 12.01.2012, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for interim bail for two months to the petitioner on the ground of taking care of wife of the petitioner. He contends that the wife of the petitioner has undergone a surgery and no one is there to take care of her during her treatment and to attend her properly.

On 26.05.2023, learned State counsel had sought time to file reply along with medical report of wife of the petitioner.

Today custody certificate along with compliance report has been filed by the respondent-State, which are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State while referring to the compliance report submitted that the medical record of Sukhpal Kaur, wife of the petitioner was verified who was admitted in hospital on 23.05.2023 due to problem in Gall Bladder and Uterus and was discharged from hospital on 28.05.2023. Learned State counsel further submits that the son of the petitioner namely Harjodh Singh Sandhu is residing with the wife of the petitioner and is taking care of her after the treatment and the medical condition of wife of the petitioner is normal.

In view of above, this Court finds no ground to entertain this petition and is not inclined to grant the concession of interim bail to the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed accordingly.
