[1] Mr. Rajneesh Malhotra, learned counsel for the Insurance Company states that award of the learned MACT, granting compensation of Rs.3,14,500/- was set aside vide order dated 13.01.2014 in FAO No.4123 of 2008 filed by the owner of the truckin case titled as 'Wazir SinghversusSmt. Krishna and others', and the matter was remanded to the learned Tribunal to decide the matter afresh.

[2] Learned counsel contends that pursuant thereto, the amount of Rs.3,14,500/- awarded by the learned Tribunal to the appellants-claimants was enhanced to Rs.7,11,400/- vide Award dated 21.08.2015 passed by the learned Tribunal, Gurgaon and that FAO No. 59 of 2016 filed by the owner against said Award was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 03.03.2020, therefore, the instant appeal became infructuous on remand of the matter to the learned MACT, Gurgaon vide order dated
