The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.32 dated 14.04.2023 registered under Sections 323, 458, 427, 148 and 149 of the IPC, 1860 at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar (Rural).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.05.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 03.08.2023 by way of an affidavit of Sanjeev Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Sub Division Ajnala, Amritsar Rural has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 03.08.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
