This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside order dated 07.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Financial Commissioner, Government of Punjab, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat, Chandigarh (Exercising the power of Government under the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994) in Appeal No.104 of 2021 and order dated 15.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Director, Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab, vide which, the petitioner had been suspended from the post of Panch and the appeal against the same has been dismissed.

Learned State Counsel has pointed out that the petitioner has

now been dismissed after regular enquiry, on 14.11.2022 and has thus, submitted that the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous.

Today, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner in order to rebut the abovesaid fact.
