[1] The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.183 dated 05.06.2015 under Sections 420/120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Dakha, Police District Ludhiana, Rural and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the same FIR based upon the compromise dated 16.05.2016.

[2] On the last date of hearing, i.e. 07.02.2023, nobody has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioners and Registry was directed to inform the learned counsel for the petitioners about the next date fixed. Registry has informed that the learned counsel for the petitioners has been informed about the date fixed. However, today, nobody has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioners.

[3] However, at this stage, learned State Counsel, on instructions from *ASI Rajvarinder Pal Singh*, states that in the present case, petitioner No.1 has already died and petitioner No.2 has already been acquitted on 31.03.2023 and therefore, nothing survives in the present case.

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[4] In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State Counsel, the present petition is *dismissed*.
