VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to provide adequate security to them as they apprehend a threat to their lives from respondent Nos.4 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are living in a live-in relationship. He submits that both are majors. The copies of 'Aadhaar' card (Annexures P-1 and P-2) of petitioner Nos.1 and 2 have been placed on record.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Without commenting upon the legality or otherwise of the said relationship, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2

to consider the representation dated 24.05.2023 (Annexure P-3) and take requisite

action, if so warranted, as per the facts and circumstances of the matter in
accordance with law.
