VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.3 and 4 to remove the two barriers/iron gates installed at both ends of the public street connecting street no.2 and 3 in Narendra Colony, Malerkotla.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after giving full and better particulars including particulars with respect to where the land in question is situated and which is the authority that is required to take action under the relevant statute with respect to the grievance raised by the petitioners.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
