The present writ petition has been filed for seeking quashing the Online Entry made in E Vahan with regard to Registration Number PCT 0001/PCT 1 by the respondent No.6. A further direction was also sought for respondents to carry out necessary action so that the name of the petitioner is correctly reflected in the Online E vahan portal.

A compliance report by way of affidavit of Moneesh Kumar, IAS, State Transport Commissioner, Punjab has been filed on behalf respondent No.2 today in Court wherein it has been averred that a regular registration No. PB 13 BR 5180 for his motor car (LMV) has been issued on 25.08.2023 in lieu of the old registration No. PCT 0001 surrendered by him.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that there is an

incorrect recording in the above said affidavit as the old Registration number has been surrendered by respondent No.7-Harbhajan Singh son of Jagat Singh and not by the petitioner and further contends that even though regular registration number PB 13 BR 5180 has been issued, however, the erstwhile registration No. PCT-0001 is still reflected in the name of respondent No.7 as per the E vahan portal of the respondents.

Counsel for respondent No.7 contends that they have already surrendered the aforesaid number and would have no objection to the appropriate rectification being carried out by the official respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Rahul Sharma, Senior Legal Assistant contends that necessary correction in the online Portal of the respondent Department shall be carried out within a period of two weeks under intimation to the petitioner so that the petitioner can avail the insurance for the said vehicle.

In view of the aforesaid undertaking, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage. Needless to mention that the respondents shall remain bound by their statement made today in Court.
