Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record copy of the representation dated 01.06.2023, sent through e-mail, to respondent No. 3-Director General of Police Haryana, Panchkula, Haryana, seeking cancellation of the FIR No. 115 dated 11.05.2022 under Sections 120-B, 384, 385, 386, 389, 506 IPC (Sections 420, 467, 468, 170, 471 IPC, added lateron), registered at Police Station New Colony, Gurugram (Annexur P-1).
