Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to pay the amount which would be due towards the original allottee and would also move an application for transfer of the shop in the name of the petitioner, who had Power of Attorney in their favour from the original allottee. The said representation would be submitted by the petitioner within a period of two weeks.

In the light of the above, we dispose of the writ petition without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon. In case, such a representation is submitted by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and appropriate order in accordance with law passed by the competent authority i.e., the Chairman Improvement Trust, Jalandhar, and further steps be taken in accordance with the

provisions of the statute and in case of acceptance of the representation, for approval of the government.

The present writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
