The petitioner through instant petition is seeking quashing of FIR No.95 dated 03.11.2017 registered at Police Station Women Ludhiana, District Ludhiana under Sections 406 and 498-A of IPC and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia* contends that dispute between the parties is on account of temperamental issues. There is no dispute on account of dowry. The marriage between the parties was solemnized on 04.12.2016 and FIR came to be registered on 03.11.2017. The petitioner immediately after his marriage left for Australia on 15.10.2017.

Learned State counsel, who is present in Court on advance notice, submits that the police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed.

On being confronted with the said fact, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file afresh with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
