AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR mentioned below:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
162	28 th November, 2018	Tibba, District Ludhiana	22 and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985

2. One of the main ground for seeking bail is that trial is not proceeding at a decent pace.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that prosecution evidence is complete.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.

6. There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the court concerned for expeditious disposal of the trial, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
7. Since the main case has been dismissed as withdrawn, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
