1. By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, prayer has been made for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.0047 dated 14.03.2023, under Sections 307, 379-B(2), 364, 353, 186, 506, 332 and 341 IPC, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

2. As per allegations, the petitioner, who was travelling in Roadways Bus, when she refused to purchase ticket for her girl child and was made to alight from the bus, she allegedly called 5/6 boys, who thereafter, gave abuses and beatings to the Conductor of the bus, resulting into the registration of present FIR.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no injury has been attributed to the present petitioner, who is a young lady of 33 years of age having two small children to take care of and has already suffered incarceration for a period of more than 2-1/2 months, besides, there is no

other case pending against the her

4. On the other hand, prayer made in the present petition has been vehemently opposed by learned State counsel while submitting that the petitioner was actively instrumental in the entire incident and, thus, she does not deserve the concession of regular bail.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the paper-book. I find substance in submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

6. Considering the fact that the petitioner is a young lady of 33 years of age having two small children and has already suffered incarceration for more than 2½ months, besides, there being no other case pending against her, especially, no injury having been attributed to her in the present case, I do not find any reason to extend her incarceration, any further.

7. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
