Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that inadvertently, the petitioner did not raise a claim for the grant of marks under the socio-economic criteria being Orphan while filling up the application form for Group-D posts but, during the selection process, he had already raised the said claim so as to fall within the selection zone. Learned counsel submits that keeping in view the fact that even as of now, certain posts in the category in which the petitioner is competing, are lying vacant and the petitioner's claim can be considered as nobody else will be prejudiced, the respondents be directed to grant the petitioner the benefit of 05 marks under the socio-economic criteria being Orphan so as to

consider his claim against the posts though advertised but are still lying vacant.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that he has no instructions as to whether any post as advertised in the category in which the petitioner was competing, is lying vacant, but in case , the petitioner raises any such claim before the authorities concerned with corroborating evidence, the said claim will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, after deciding of the claim, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.
