1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.3 to 5 to allow the petitioner to work as Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat Bhattan, Block Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib and to hand over the charge for the post of Sarpanch to the petitioner.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Mohit Kalyan, BDPO, Amloh, has submitted that the charge has already been handed over to the petitioner and the petitioner is working as Sarpanch and has also put an agenda for the panchayat meeting.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present writ petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but prays that the

respondents-State be bound by the said statement.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

5. Respondents-State would be bound by the statement made before this Court.
