The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0083 dated 12.05.2023 under Sections 15, 17, 29 of the NDPS Act 61 of 1985 and Section 25 of the Arms Act No.54 of 1959 registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 27.07.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 27.07.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the interim order dated 27.07.2023 is made absolute.

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However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
