MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. are seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents not to harass and humiliate them at the behest of private respondents without following due process of law.

Learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to the affidavit of DSP, Moga, which was filed in the Court on 21.09.2021, and has submitted that totally frivolous and concocted allegations have been levelled by the petitioners against the official respondents of harassing and humiliating them. He submits that in fact the petitioners have criminal antecedents. In support, learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to paragraph No.7 of their reply, wherein details of the other cases registered against the petitioners stand mentioned.

Case has been called twice, however, nobody has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioners to controvert the submissions made by learned State counsel.

In the facts and circumstances as enumerated hereinabove, this Court finds no merit in the instant petition and thus, the same stands dismissed.
