1. Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 50 dated 09.05.2022 registered under Sections 341, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Joga, District Mansa (Punjab).
2. Vide order dated 26.05.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 26.05.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Naib Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 26.05.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
