Petitioner is an accused in criminal complaint bearing No.NACT/166/2020, titled as “*Ashok Kumar v. Sarabjit Singh*”, wherein he had been allowed bail. He absented from trial on 06.04.2023, due to which his bail was cancelled and warrants of arrest were issued against him and as said warrants failed to procure his presence, proclamation was directed to be issued against him for 02.06.2023, as per order dated 27.04.2023 (Annexure P-5).

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner had appeared on 20.01.2023 and had noted the next date of hearing to be 10.04.2023 instead of 10.03.2023, due to which he could not appear on 10.03.2023. It is because of wrong noting of that date that absence of the petitioner was marked.

Petition is hereby directed to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 02.06.2023, the date already fixed thereat. On his such appearance, he shall be admitted to bail by the Trial Court. However, this is subject to cost of ₹10,000/- to be deposited by the petitioner in the District Legal Services Authority, Amritsar. In case, the

petitioner fails to make compliance of any of these conditions, this order shall be deemed to have no effect.
