The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of FIR No.247 dated 12.11.2017 under Sections 366 and 380 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Vide order dated 01.06.2022 passed by co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the present petition has already been dismissed as having been rendered infructuous qua petitioner No.1/daughter of respondent No.2 herein, in view of the order dated 09.03.2022 (Annexure A-1).

Learned State counsel submits that vide order dated 07.07.2022 passed by Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, the present FIR bearing No.247 dated 12.11.2017 under Sections 366 and 380 of IPC, registered at

Police Station Sadar Amritsar, Amritsar itself stands quashed and therefore, nothing survives in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent No.2 admits the above submissions on behalf of the State to be true.

In view of the above said admitted position between the parties, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
