**CRM-3549-2023:**

Prayer in the present application is for withdrawal of main case,  
i.e. CRM-M-9134-2017.

Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner submits that since  
the matter has been amicably settled between the parties, therefore, the  
applicant/petitioner does not intend to pursue the present matter any further.  
Hence, he may be permitted to withdraw the main case, being  
CRM-M-9134-2017, in view of the said settlement arrived at between the  
parties.

The aforesaid factum of amicable settlement arrived at between

the parties is also not disputed by learned counsel appearing for the respondent.

In view of the above, CRM-M-9134-2017 is permitted to be withdrawn on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Application is accordingly disposed of.
