The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.123 dated 25.10.2022 registered under Sections 307, 323, 341, 148, 149, 427 IPC, Sections 452, 212, 336 IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act added later on at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar Commissionerate.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.05.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 29.05.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
