[1] Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 3 (1)(d) read with Sub Section 3 (2) (b) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 for directing the respondents to grant him six weeks' parole to meet his family members.

[2] Learned AAG states that vide order dated 01.08.2023, District Magistrate, Ludhiana has sanctioned the application of the petitioner for parole of eight weeks. Copy of the order dated 01.08.2023 produced by the learned AAG in Court today is taken on record. The same has also been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that in view of sanction of parole to the petitioner, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is dismissed as not calling for any further orders.
