The petitioner is personally present in the Court. Through this writ petition, the petitioner prays for direction to the respondents to transfer her to any available place of posting which enables her to carry out the administrative work. She claims to be partially blind to the extent of 40%. Before filing the writ petition, she has already submitted two representations (Annexures P-6 and P-7). She further claims to have been posted 105 kms away from her home.

After having heard the petitioner, this Court at the first instance directs the Principal Secretary, Department of Revenue and Rehabilitation, Punjab, to consider her request within a period of one month, after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, by passing a speaking order.

With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
