1. By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, prayer has been made for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.40 dated 21.01.2023, under Sections 379-A and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

2. As per the FIR, the allegation against the petitioner is that he along with his co-accused snatched bag, Rs.4000/- and mobile phone from the complainant.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for the last 4 months and the trial is likely to take some time. He further submits that there is no other case registered against the petitioner and thus, he prays for grant of concession of regular bail.

4. On the other hand learned State counsel opposes the prayer made on behalf of the petitioner while referring to the allegations levelled in the present FIR.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the paper-book. I find substance in submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

6. Considering the fact that there is no other case registered against the petitioner and he has already suffered incarceration for 4 months, the investigation in the present case already stands concluded with the filing of challan and trial is likely to take some time, I do not find any justified reason to extend his incarceration any further.

7. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
