The petitioner has assailed the order dated 08.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala vide which the application under Section 437(6) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, has been dismissed and also the order dated 20.01.2017 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Kapurthala vide which the revision has been dismissed.

Learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Naveen Kumar, submits that the case qua the petitioner has finally disposed of in the trial Court in terms of the judgment dated 13.07.2017 and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

As none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion put-forth by the learned State Counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
