The petitioners have filed the present petition seeking quashing of FIR No.226 dated 24.11.2018 under Sections 325, 323, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise as well as affidavit dated 06.08.2020 (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the dispute is basically matrimonial in nature, however, the case is still under investigation. He further submits that now the parties have resolved the dispute amicably.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has also affirmed the factum regarding compromise.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, has submitted that the case is under investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has fairly submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to pursue their remedy as available to them under law.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

However, the State is directed to expedite the investigation and conclude the same preferably within a period of four weeks from today keeping in view the nature of the case and the compromise arrived at between the parties.
