ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 07.12.2019,
vide which following direction was issued: -

*“Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to
the respondents to award 1 mark to the petitioner for work
experience, afford opportunity of hearing to all the stakeholders
including the petitioner likely to be affected by change of merit,
re-determine their merit and pass consequential appropriate
order.”*

At the first instance, affidavit was filed by the Registrar, Panjab University, Chandigarh, in which it is stated that a speaking order was passed declining prayer of the petitioner.

Thereafter, on 09.12.2020, in this petition itself, a direction was issued to the respondent to grant one mark and thereafter, re-determine the merits and pass consequential appropriate order. In compliance thereof, another affidavit has been filed by the Registrar, Panjab University, Chandigarh. As per speaking order dated 16.12.2020, one mark is awarded to petitioner Narinder Singh Gusain on account of his experience and on re-determination of his seniority, he is placed above 23 persons. Simultaneously, a notice was issued to those effected persons.

Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record copy of the order dated 18.07.2022 passed in LPA-482-2022 to submit that LPA Bench has stayed operation of the order dated 07.12.2019.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous.
