MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(Oral)

The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.0009 dated 17.01.2023 as registered at Police Station Model Town, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Sita Ram from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the orders passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 30.05.2023 and this Court on 05.07.2023, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in

any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to petitioner-Prabhjot Singh by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 30.05.2023, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
