This petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of F.I.R. No.117 dated 11.03.2023 registered under Sections 120-B, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 472 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sohana, District Gurugram and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of joint affidavit dated 07.04.2023 (Annexure P-2).

Separate power of attorneys on behalf of respondents No.2 & 3 & victim- Payal Kumar have been filed.
