The petitioner(s) allege violation of the order dated 10.07.2017,
vide which status quo regarding possession was directed to be maintained.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that BDPO, Village
Dhilwan, District Kapurthala, in violation of the aforesaid order, sought
information from the Gram Panchayat, Village Mand Chakoki, District
Kapurthala as to why the action is not being taken.

As per compliance affidavits of DDPO, Kapurthala as well as of
Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat Chakoki, Tehsil Dhilwan, District Kapurthala, in

fact only a query was put by BDPO, who has been suspended and neither any auction proceedings took place nor any effort to take possession was made.

In view of the above, no willful disobedience is made out.

Accordingly, both these petitions are dismissed.
