Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 to 5 to look into the matter and take appropriate action against accused in pursuance to the representations dated 12.07.2021 and 15.03.2023 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) in accordance with law.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that FIR No.0064, dated 16.05.2020, under Section 188 IPC, at Police Station Sandaur, District Malerkotla has been registered against the petitioner and during the investigation, the allegations made against the petitioner were found to be false and thus, he was exonerated. He has further contended that the petitioner has filed representation dated 12.07.2021 (Annexure P-7) before the Deputy Commissioner, Malerkotla and 15.03.2023 (Annexure P-8) before the Director General of Police

(Punjab), for the redressal of his claim which are still pending consideration.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, to look into the representation (if any filed by the petitioner within a period of one week from today) and decide the same within a period of one month from the date of filing of the representation, in accordance with law.
