The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0049 dated 08.05.2023 registered under Sections 379 IPC and Section 21 of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation Act, 1957) at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 24.07.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 24.07.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
