Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of impugned order dated 25.01.2017 (P-3), passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar in NDPS Case No.623 dated 02.06.2023 arising out of FIR No.08 dated 28.01.2016, under Sections 3, 34/20 of the Passport Act, 1967; Section 14 of the Foreigners Act, 1946; Section 511 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860; Sections 21, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station, Ajnala, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar, whereby bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner were forfeited.
