Even on the previous date, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner. A perusal of the file shows that notice of motion was issued subject to deposit of 50% of the litigation costs awarded against the petitioner by the trial Court within a week.

The matter has been listed after considerable time after outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

On 10.10.2022, the following order was passed:

“As per office report, the order dated 19.07.2019 has not been complied with as 50 % of the litigation costs awarded against the petitioner by the trial Court has not been deposited.

As there is no representation on behalf of the parties, therefore, in the interest of justice, adjourned to 27.01.2023.

Since the matter has been listed for the first time after the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, registry is directed to notify learned counsel for the parties about the date fixed.”

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that as per the status depicted on the national data grid, the proceedings from which the present revision petition arises has been disposed of vide order dated 16.12.2019 by Principal Judge (Family Court), Gurugram.

In view of above noted position, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
