By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the quashing of the FIR bearing No.106 dated 17.07.2022 registered at Police Station GRP Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, under Section 306 IPC as well as the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Mr. Kunwarbir Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar from the above-said Police Station, he apprises the Court that the investigation has not yet been concluded in the afore-referred case.

3. In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, at this stage, while submitting that if there

need be, the petitioner would file a fresh petition for seeking the same relief, as prayed for in this petition, at the appropriate stage, i.e after the conclusion of the investigation proceedings.

- 5. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
