As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and the respondent Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.6,20,000/- over and above, the amount awarded by the learned Tribunal is allowed to the appellants No.1 and 2 in equal share, as full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque amounting to Rs.6,20,000/- in the name of appellants No.1 and 2 within a period of thirty days from today, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 6% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque from the learned counsel/representative of the respondent Insurance Company. The appellant(s) counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
