1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to issue passport in view of the fact that police has submitted cancellation report in FIR No.41 dated 18.03.2015 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at police Station Sirhali District Tarn Taran.
