(1) Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 - Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission and respondent No.3 - Director General, Department of State Transport, Haryana to take decision on representations dated 10.04.2023 (Annexure P-16) and dated 05.04.2023 (Annexure P-15), respectively made by the petitioner.

(2) Learned State counsel, who appears on advance notice, has no objection if the above prayer is accepted.

(3) Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 - Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission and respondent No.3 - Director General, Department of State Transport, Haryana to take decision

on representations dated 10.04.2023 (Annexure P-16) and dated 05.04.2023 (Annexure P-15), respectively, by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

(4) Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
