The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.109 dated 22.5.2022 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 167, 170 IPC registered at Police Station City, Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 27.7.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raj Masih admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 27.7.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
