1. The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Revisional Authority concerned, to decide most expeditiously, the revision petition bearing No.ER-02/2022-23 dated 08.04.2022. Moreover, the Revisional Court concerned, shall also make a lawful order upon the apposite application claiming interim relief, hence for staying the operation of the orders, as made by the authorities, thus below the Revisional Authority, whereby the eviction of the present petitioner from the disputed lands, thus has been ordered.
2. In the larger interest of justice, the Revisional Authority concerned, may not, till it makes a lawful speaking decision, on the said interim application, choose to draw any coercive action in respect of the disputed lands.
