Present application has been filed for recalling the order dated 25.09.2023, by which, the present writ petition was dismissed for non-prosecution.

Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He raises no objection for the grant of prayer as raised in the present application.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, coupled with the fact that learned counsel for the respondents has not objected to the relief as prayed in the present application, the same is allowed. The order dated 25.09.2023 is recalled and the writ petition is restored to its original number and status.

CWP-13999-2020

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present petition, the claim of the petitioner is for reimbursement of the medical expenses in respect of the treatment undertaken by Sh. Hawa Singh, who was working in the Health Department as a Class-IV employee. Learned counsel submits that as per the reply filed, in paragraph 1 of the preliminary objections, it has been mentioned that the medical bills, the reimbursement of which is being claimed, has not been supplied and as and when the same will be supplied, the same will be taken into consideration and appropriate order will be passed in regards to the said claim, hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents with the copies of the medical bills.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that within a period of eight weeks of submission of the relevant medical bills, appropriate order will be passed on the claim of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above, as prayed for by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
