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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. This is second petition filed under Section 439 read with Section 437 (6) of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 80 dated 08.02.2019 registered under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa. The earlier petition stood dismissed as withdrawn, vide order dated 09.02.2023 (Annexure P-1), passed by this Court in CRM-M-27392-2022.

2. Learned State counsel submits that out of total 20 witnesses, 19 witnesses have already been examined and 1 witness remains to be examined.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition at this stage, however, he submits that appropriate directions may be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial in a time bound manner.
4. In view of aforesaid submission made by learned counsel for petitioner, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage. The trial Court shall make endeavours to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within a period of 6 months from today.
5. All pending application (s), if any, shall stand closed.
